## INTRODUCTION

Reproducing a shape for large or small productions, but also creating unique objects from a casting or pressure mould, simplifying the working processes; this is the dream of many ceramists.

The trainer Marco Malavolti will present an effective, simple and creative programme for the creation of multi-part casting and pressure moulds. The course will start with an idea and a personal project and will then develop a model which will be analysed before making your own mould.

The course is aimed at a group of a maximum of 4 people and this will give participants the opportunity to develop many of their own personal designs, even large ones.







## PROGRAM

**DAY 01** 

07/05 | 7 hours | 9.00-17.00

Presentation of the course and introduction of the moulding technique;

Preparation of soap (release agent for plaster parts);

Development and analysis of each participant's project;

Realisation of a simple mould in one or two parts;

Calculation of shrinkage according to the sand to be used for production;

Lost mould: realisation of an earth model and subsequent transformation into a plaster model;

**DAY 02** 

08/05 | 7 hours | 9.00-17.00

Finishing the model;

Mould making;

Making a multi-part mould;

**DAY 03** 

09/05 | 7 hours | 9.00-17.00

Using silicone rubber to make a model;

Multiples of the same mould using the rubber model;

**DAY 04** 

10/05 | 7 hours | 9.00-17.00

Mould in several parts;

Study of a mould to be made in several parts;

**DAY 05** 

11/05 | 7 hours | 9.00-16.00

Processing of moulds in progress;

Comparison of the various projects faced by the trainees;

Final evaluation.
